Itinerary

Day 1: Amboseli Sentrim Camp Experience

- Upon arriving at Nairobi Airport, our friendly representative will guide you through immigration and customs. Your adventure begins as you head to Amboseli National Park with captivating game drives en route to the Amboseli Sentrim Camp. Check-in and enjoy a buffet lunch upon arrival.
- The camp, situated deep within the reserve, promises close encounters with elephants, buffalos, wildebeest, giraffes, and more. Explore the grasslands on an afternoon game drive, marveling at the breathtaking views of Kilimanjaro.
- The park hosts over 420 bird species, and its underground springs attract a diverse range of wildlife, including a significant elephant population.
- Conclude your day with a delightful dinner and an overnight stay at the lodge.



Day 2: Woodland Wonders

- Today's adventure includes a tasty breakfast, morning and afternoon game drives, or an entire day of exploration with a picnic lunch in Amboseli National Park.
- Head to Mount Kilimanjaro. The park is renowned for its feline inhabitants, including lions, leopards, cheetahs, and civet cats. Make sure you enjoy your lunch in between this fantastic adventure.
- Witness graceful impalas in the woodlands, black-faced vervet monkeys, and Olive Baboons. Open waters host hippos, while buffalos graze on the shoreline. Admire the large elephant population, observing their intricate rituals and the protective care of the adult females.
- Encounter the legendary Maasai warriors, proud nomads known globally for their battle prowess and bravery in facing wild animals.
- Conclude your day with a delicious dinner and overnight stay at the lodge.



Day 3:Central Kenyan Oasis

- Following an early breakfast, journey to the Lake Elementaita region and check in to your accommodation by the lake just in time for lunch.
- After a late lunch, enjoy the lodge's amenities and relax by the picturesque Lake Elementaita. Nestled in the Great Rift Valley between Lake Naivasha and Lake Nakuru, this soda lake is framed by the silhouette of the Sleeping Warrior Hill. The lake boasts a diverse avian population home to over 400 bird species, including the iconic flamingos. Be sure to take pleasure in your lunch amidst this incredible journey.
- Enjoy the sight of ducks, geese, kingfishers, pelicans, and many more.
- Conclude your day with a delightful dinner and an overnight stay at the lodge.

Day 4:Maasai Mara Marvels

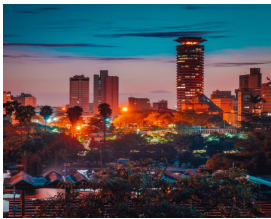
- Following breakfast, set out for the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Arrive in time for lunch and savour tea or coffee at 4:00 PM. Afterwards, embark on an exhilarating game drive, the highlight being the chance to spot lions, cheetahs, and other magnificent predators.
- As the day winds down, relish a delightful dinner at your camp. The Maasai Mara, spanning 1510 square kilometres, is a world-renowned reserve with open grasslands and abundant wildlife, including Africa's famous "big five." Reach Sentrim Mara Camp for lunch, nestled in the African wilderness between two hills.
- Situated at an elevation of 1780 meters, this deluxe camp offers a personalized safari experience with high service standards and cuisine—a true home away from home in the Maasai Mara.
- Enjoy some fantastic cuisines for dinner.

Day 5: Wildlife Haven

- Kickstart your day with early morning tea or coffee before embarking on a game drive in the Mara. Opt for an early morning and evening game drive with a hot lunch and breakfast at the lodge or a full-day game drive with a picnic lunch.
- The Mara, west of Nairobi and bordering Tanzania's Serengeti, boasts breathtaking scenery and an abundance of wildlife. It preserves the splendor of Kenya's past, allowing visitors to witness animals in superabundance. The Mara River, flowing through the reserve, sustains diverse ecosystems, hosting lions, buffalo, zebras, and more.
- Crocodiles and hippos dwell in the river, while leopards and elephants favor the woodlands.
- Conclude your day with meals at the lodge and an overnight stay in this captivating reserve.

Day 6: Nairobi: Green City in the Sun

- After breakfast, head to Nairobi, arriving in time for lunch at a local Indian restaurant (not included). Later, partake in a city tour starting from Nairobi City Centre, moving to the city's heart for shopping and exploring local stores.
- The tour includes iconic landmarks like Parliament buildings and the Kenyatta International Conference Centre. Enjoy a breathtaking view from a lookout point and visit the city market for shopping.
- Nairobi, known as the "green city in the sun," is a vibrant and growing metropolis with a cosmopolitan atmosphere, high-rise buildings, and lush greenery.
- Go for an overnight stay at the hotel.
