### Itinerary


#### Day 1: Arrival in Cochin

Upon arrival in Cochin, also known as the Queen of the Arabian Sea, you'll be met and assisted before being transferred to your prebooked hotel. Once settled, embark on a sightseeing tour of Cochin. Explore Fort Cochin Beach, Willington Island, Mattancherry Palace, Chinese Fishing Nets, Paradesi Synagogue, and the Church of St. Francis. Later in the afternoon, continue your exploration with visits to the Jewish Synagogue, Mattancherry Palace (Dutch Palace), St. Francis Church, and Santa Cruz Basilica. Conclude your day with a mesmerizing Kathakali Dance Show, showcasing the vibrant colors and cultural richness of this traditional dance form. Overnight stay in Cochin.



#### Day 2: Cochin to Munnar

After breakfast, depart for Munnar, a scenic hill station renowned for its lush greenery and tea plantations. En route, visit the Kodanadu Elephant Training Camp. Upon arrival in Munnar, check into your hotel and unwind. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Overnight stay in Munnar.



#### Day 3: Explore Munnar

After breakfast, set out for a hiking tour near Lakshmi Hills, immersing yourself in the breathtaking wilderness, wildlife, and exotic flora of the region. Later, visit the Eravikulam National Park, home to rare flora, fauna, and the endangered Nilgiri Tahr. Take in the panoramic views and explore the tea plantations in the afternoon. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.



#### Day 4:Munnar to Periyar

Following breakfast, proceed to Periyar, a picturesque resort destination ideal for relaxation. Check into Spice Village upon arrival. In the evening, enjoy a serene boat safari on Periyar Lake, where you may catch glimpses of rare birds and animals at Periyar National Park. Return to the hotel for overnight accommodation.



#### Day 5:Periyar to Kumarakom

After breakfast, depart for Kumarakom, situated on the banks of Lake Vembanad. Engage in coconut plucking and learn traditional coconut preparation methods, flavored with exotic spices. Visit the Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary to witness a myriad of rare bird species. Return to the hotel for overnight stay.



#### Day 6:Kumarakom to Alleppey

After breakfast, travel to Alleppey to board a traditional houseboat locally known as Kettuvallam. Cruise through the picturesque backwaters of Alleppey, observing and experiencing the daily life of village communities along the waterways. Overnight stay on the houseboat.



#### Day 7:Departure from Cochin

Disembark from the houseboat after breakfast and drive to Cochin airport for your onward journey, marking the end of your memorable Kerala tour.
