



Explore Bhutan

Itinerary

Day 1: Transfer to Thimphu

Begin your journey by boarding a DRUK Air flight from Indira Gandhi Airport in Delhi to Paro. The flight offers breathtaking views as it traverses the Himalayan range. Upon arrival in Paro, you'll be greeted by the crisp mountain air and assisted through immigration. Then, embark on a scenic drive to Thimphu, Bhutan's capital city. En route, stop at Chuzom, the confluence of Thimphu and Paro rivers, adorned with three distinct styles of stupas. Continue to Thimphu and check into your hotel. Explore Thimphu Main Street, the market area, and the Local Crafts Bazaar, showcasing Bhutan's traditional arts. Overnight stay in Thimphu.



Day 2: Thimphu Exploration

After breakfast, visit Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang), offering panoramic views of Thimphu valley. Embark on the "Buddha Nature Trail" from Buddha Point to Changangkha Lhakhang, enjoying a serene hike through a pristine forest. Explore Changangkha Lhakhang, a fortress-like temple and monastic school offering stunning views of Thimphu valley. After lunch, visit Pangri Zampa, one of Bhutan's oldest monasteries, and the Bhutan Post Office and Traditional Paper-making factory. Conclude the day with a visit to Trashichhoedzong, an impressive fortress-monastery. Overnight stay in Thimphu.



Day 3: Thimphu to Punakha

After breakfast, drive to Punakha via Dochula pass, offering spectacular views of the eastern Himalayas. Enjoy a walking excursion to Chimi Lhakhang, also known as the temple of fertility. Continue to Punakha and visit Punakha Dzong, a massive structure at the confluence of two rivers. Explore Punakha village in the evening. Overnight stay in Punakha.



Day 4: Punakha to Paro

After breakfast, drive to Paro. En route, visit Simtokha Dzong, the oldest fortress in Bhutan. Upon arrival in Paro, check into your hotel and visit Ta Dzong, now housing the National Museum, followed by Rinpung Dzong (Paro Dzong). Overnight stay in Paro.



Day 5: Paro Exploration

Embark on an excursion to Taktshang Monastery, famously known as Tiger's Nest, perched on a cliffside overlooking the Paro valley. Visit Drukgyel Dzong, a ruined fortress with views of Mount Chomolhari. In the evening, visit Kyichu Lhakhang, one of the 108 temples built by Tibetan King Songtsen Gampo. Overnight stay in Paro.



Day 6: Depart from Paro

After breakfast, bid farewell to Bhutan as you transfer to Paro airport for your onward flight, concluding your memorable journey through the Land of the Thunder Dragon.
